Purpose

Bloomfield Street recognises that businesses have a responsibility to operate in a way that minimises environmental impact and supports sustainable, responsible growth.

As a digital-first operational consultancy, Bloomfield Street's direct environmental footprint is relatively low compared with many traditional industries. However, we believe environmental responsibility is not defined solely by scale. It is reflected in the operational decisions organisations make every day, including how they work, travel, purchase services, use technology, reduce waste, and design sustainable ways of operating.

We believe effective operations and environmental responsibility are closely connected. Poorly designed systems, duplication of effort, unnecessary travel, inefficient processes, and unclear ownership all contribute to wasted time, resources, energy, and cost. Strong operational foundations can therefore support both business resilience and more sustainable working practices.

This statement outlines Bloomfield Street's approach to environmental responsibility and our commitment to continuous improvement in line with applicable UK environmental legislation, relevant European sustainability principles, and recognised good practice appropriate to the size and nature of the business.

Our Commitment

Bloomfield Street is committed to:

- Operating responsibly and seeking to minimise unnecessary environmental impact
- Maintaining paper-light, digital-first working practices wherever practical
- Reducing waste and encouraging efficient use of resources
- Supporting remote and hybrid ways of working where appropriate
- Minimising unnecessary business travel and associated emissions wherever practical

- Encouraging sustainable operational practices through our consultancy work

Digital-First Operations

As part of supplier and procurement decision-making, Bloomfield Street may consider factors such as:

- Digital-first service provision
- Reduction of paper-based processes

- Sustainable hosting or infrastructure approaches where relevant
- Compliance with applicable environmental and legal obligations

The business primarily uses digital and cloud-based operational systems to support efficient service delivery and minimise unnecessary physical resource usage.
